After breakfast, take a tour in Cairo where you really get a feel for the real Egyptian local life. It's so easy to fall in love with this city,

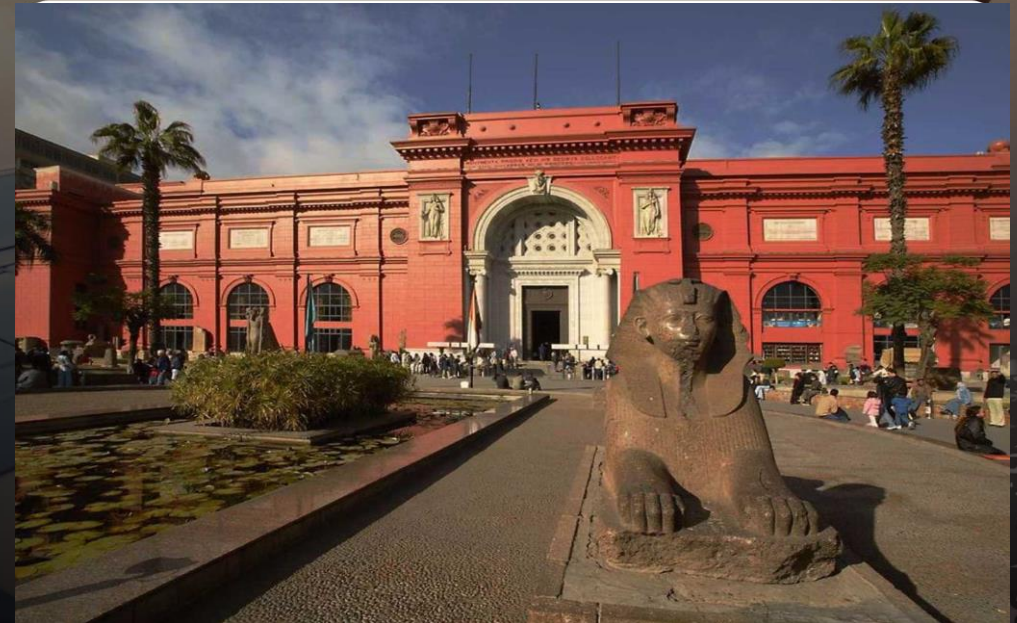
Giza Pyramids

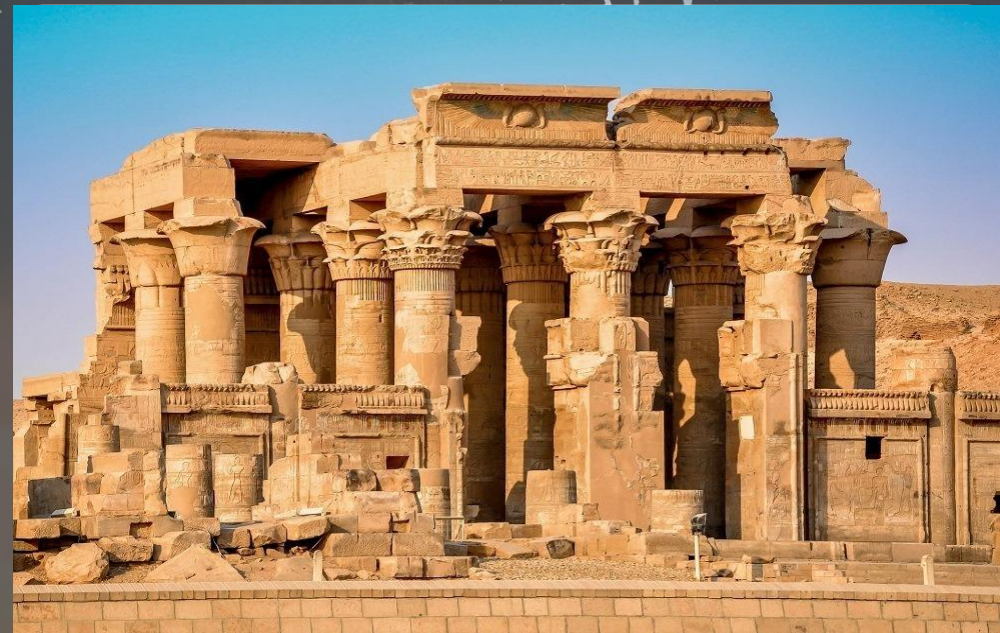
We will enjoy the road from Aswan to Luxor by visiting **Kom Ombo temple**,

The only monument in Luxor that is not home-crafted as it was made in Cairo in the region of Amenhotep 3, and moved across 700 km to stand at the entrance of the city.

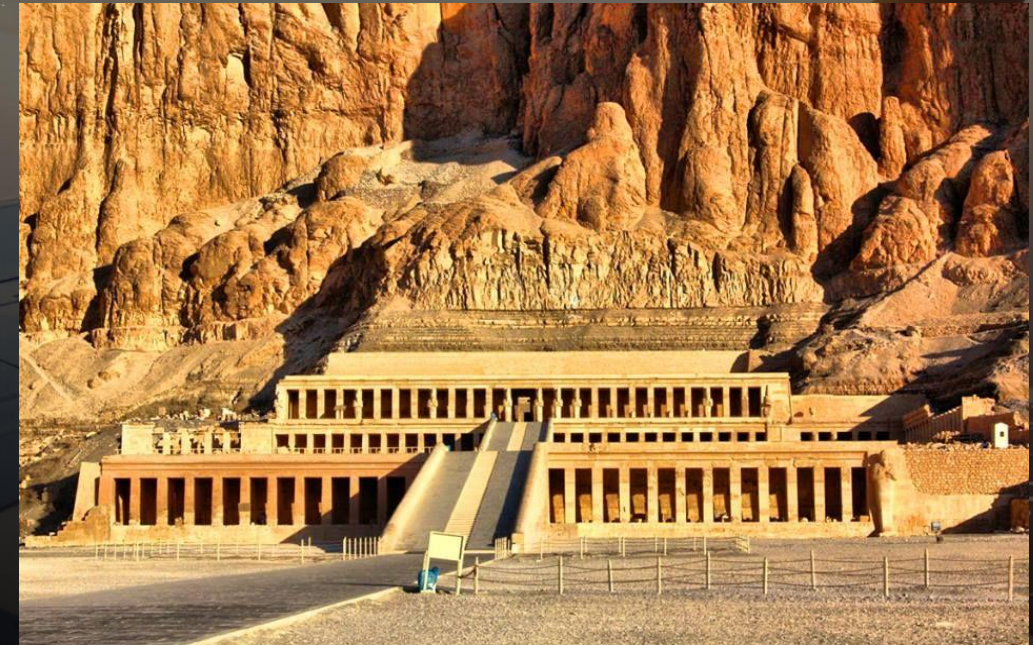
